

Introduction

Welcome to the new FFT Live 3.0 which provides schools and Local Education Authorities with a range of online reports to support target setting and self evaluation. We have significantly extended the range of reports available to schools and many reports are now available at school, group and individual pupil level.

The move to online pupil level data is a significant step forward and should allow more teachers to gain direct access to pupil data. We believe this is vitally important as the effective use of pupil level data in the classroom can have the greatest impact on pupil and school improvement.

If you already use FFT Live, you'll also find that the new version has some welcome improvements to the site including:

- improved look and feel
- additional reporting functionality
- improved exporting and printing

FFT Live 3.0 – a summary of the reports available to schools at www.fftlive.org

Significant Areas (Updated/New) – two reports allow schools to quickly highlight potential strengths, weaknesses and trends across a range of indicators, subjects and pupil groups over a 3 year period. The reports are available for Key Stages 2, 3 and 4.

KS4 Subject Value Added (Updated) – two reports highlight potential subject strengths and weaknesses at Key Stage 4 by comparing the progress of pupils in your school to the progress of similar pupils nationally.

Pupil Value Added (New and only available through 'P' logins – see below for details) – A range of pupil level value added reports which compare the actual progress made by individual pupils against the progress made by similar pupils nationally. Large differences are highlighted on reports. The reports are available for Key Stages 2-4.

Pupil Estimates (New and only available through 'P' logins – see below for details) – A range of reports to support target setting for individual children and young people. Reports now use 'chances' or 'probabilities' of achieving individual levels/grades allowing teachers to see the whole range of grades achieved by similar pupils last year. In FFT Live 3.0, schools are no longer restricted to 3 estimate types and can select from a range of more challenging estimates if required. The reports are available for Key Stages 2-4.

School Estimates (Updated) – These reports support school and group level target setting providing schools with estimates for a range of key indicators. The main estimates are based on the progress of similar pupils nationally last year but also include estimates based on the progress of similar pupils in your own school over the last 3 years.

Coming Soon

Further enhancements will be made to FFT Live 3.0 in the spring and summer terms. The most important of these will be the functionality to allow schools to create and manage their own FFT Live login accounts (available 31 March 2009). This will mean, for example, that a school can allow a teacher to view pupil and school level data but only allow a school governor to view school level data. Current Logins ([to access your username and password please contact your FFT LEA contact](#))

There are currently two types of school login:

6992000 - A basic login based on your school number. This login allows access to school level data only.

6992000P – as above but with a 'P' at the end. This login allows access to school AND pupil level data and therefore should be treated more securely. This login will eventually be superseded by personalised logins (see above).
